## 2. EDUCATORS

Educators are feeling overworked, underpaid and underappreciated. 55% of educators are considering a career change or early retirement



## 3. HOSPITALITY

Employee happiness is improving as this industry recovers from the effects of the pandemic. However, 87% of hotels have staff shortages.



#### 4. RESTAURANT

79% of restaurant operators are struggling to hire, leaving current employees overworked and overwhelmed.



#### 5. NONPROFIT

Employee happiness is trending upwards in 2023. It has a 71% rate of increase this year and is expected to improve further.



#### 6. FINANCE

The finance industry's openness to remote and hybrid work, as well as focus on company culture, promise to sustain high levels of satisfaction.



#### 7. TECHNOLOGY

Employee happiness is plummeting. Although it had a strong finish in 2020, this year happiness is nose diving with a 145% rate of decline.



### 8. CONSTRUCTION

Currently the happiest industry to work in, due in part to rising wages and plentiful job opportunities, but experts predict labor shortfalls.
